

Riverside County is the 10th most populous county in the nation. The Office of the District Attorney for the County of Riverside is the primary criminal prosecution agency serving approximately 2.47 million residents. The District Attorney's Summer Externship Program offers a unique opportunity for future Riverside County Career Prosecutors to be exposed to true prosecution work. The externship begins with a weeklong intensive training program that includes advanced courses in prosecutorial ethics, legal research and writing, evidence, criminal procedure, and oral advocacy. Upon completing the training program, 1L externs handle a wide variety of true legal research and writing assignments on real cases. Each assignment is for a different prosecutor in a different prosecution unit, causing the extern to be challenged with every task and to be able to work with numerous Deputy District Attorneys in a wide range of prosecution units. 1L externs also participate in an oral advocacy training program throughout the summer. 2L externs, after having completed the weeklong training program, are assigned to a vertical prosecution unit in our Riverside Office or officewide at our other locations. 2L externs must be certified by the California State Bar to appear in court. These high performing externs have their own caseload and are expected to handle their cases like an experienced prosecutor. They review cases, subpoena witnesses, put on preliminary and other evidentiary hearings, draft and argue motions, negotiate cases, and many complete as first-chair a misdemeanor jury trial, all in accordance with the California State Bar's Practical Training of Law Students program. At the conclusion of the summer, all 1L and 2L externs countywide are invited to participate in our Summer Extern Closing Argument Competition.
